#### **STATEMENT OF GENERAL INTENT:**

The Village of Dunnottar has initiated a Trap, Neuter and Release (TNR) Program to control the feral cat population.

The purpose of this policy is to establish a procedure for residents to transport a feral cat to a designated veterinary clinic for surgery and for the municipality to be responsible for the veterinary costs.

#### **POLICY GUIDELINES:**

1. Only residents of the Village of Dunnottar are eligible to participate in this program.
2. Residents must provide their name and civic address.
3. The description of the feral cat must be disclosed as well as the location it habitually occupies.
4. Those residents accepted for the program will receive a document (attached as Schedule A) for submission to the approved veterinarian.
5. Residents participating in this program will be responsible for the trapping and transporting of the feral cat. The Village of Dunnottar will cover only the necessary veterinary expenses.
